MOVITE Fall Meeting


The conference kicked off with the MOVITE Board Meeting on Wednesday, October 4th. MOVITE President, **Amanda Brauer** led the discussion. Exec members talked finances, new or modified district policies, Strategic Plan task force needs, and section news.

After the conclusion of the Board Meeting, attendees had the opportunity to take part in a technical walking tour with <u>Trailblazers</u> or volunteer at <u>Pedal It Forward</u>, a local non-profit that collects used bikes, fixes them, and donates them to those in need through various partners around the community. To wrap up the first day of the fall meeting, MOVITE members attended a welcome reception at the hotel where they enjoyed complimentary food and drinks while networking with old and new friends.

Section Spotlight



On February 5, 2003, the Ozarks Chapter of ITE (OCITE) was chartered by the institute and included 21 charter members and covered 24 counties in the Southwest Missouri region. Jason Haynes was elected as OCITE's first president. At that time, OCITE was the second chapter to be chartered under the Missouri Valley Section of ITE (MOVITE). In 2018, the ITE International board discussed the current structure of its Districts. Sections, and Chapters below the international and modified the existing definitions of each. With these changes, MOVITE was restructured into a district, resulting in OCITE being restructured into the Ozarks Section of ITE (OSITE) in 2020.

Today, OSITE continues to cover 24 counties in Southwest Missouri and consists of 62 section members and 69 section affiliates. This year, OSITE has hosted several events for both students and transportation professionals. They have hosted a Bowling Tournament, two Business Meetings, and a Student Poster competition for the Missouri State Civil Engineering Transportation class. Additionally, the OSITE Board reviewed applications and awarded three scholarships to engineering students. See next page.

Most recently, OSITE and the Ozark Mountain Section of the American Planning Association (APA) jointly held a one-day technical conference on August 2nd at the Robert W. Plaster Center for Advanced Manufacturing on the Ozarks Technical Community College (OTC) campus in Springfield, MO. The annual conference included 93 in-person attendees and consisted of presentations covering a variety of engineering and planning topics. Earl Newman was also recognized for being named an ITE Honorary Member.
