Dear **MOVITE** Members:

In early April, the LOCATE chapter hosted our membership for an outstanding and well-attended Spring meeting in Omaha, Nebraska. The technical program was extremely comprehensive, and the numerous networking / social opportunities provided were enjoyed by our members in their usual fashion — even when playing the golf scramble in near-freezing temperatures! With the new ITE awards schedule, we had the opportunity to present our student awards a bit earlier this year. We also recognized LOCATE as the best MOVITE chapter during 2017. ITE International Past President Shawn Leight attended and provided us all with an update of ITE's strategic planning efforts during our business meeting. All in all, it was a great event and was personally gratifying for me to preside over the meeting back in my home state of Nebraska.

As the designated MOVITE representative on the MWITE Executive Board for 2018, I was involved in the District's planning efforts and was then fortunate to attend the ITE International Meeting, which was hosted by the North Central Section (NCITE) and held in Minneapolis, Minnesota from August 20-23. This was a rare opportunity for me and other MOVITE members to interact with the ITE community of transportation professionals from around the world. There will be some issues resulting from this OneITE initiative that will directly affect our existing chapters and student chapters, as well as a few membership impacts resulting from ITE's bylaw changes made in 2017. Much work will be needed over the next two years to successfully accomplish this transition, but we already have a plan to do so. Vice President Andy Swisher and I, along with Section Administrator Tom Swenson and MWITE officer Martin Gugel, will lead an internal MOVITE transition team to address these issues and
